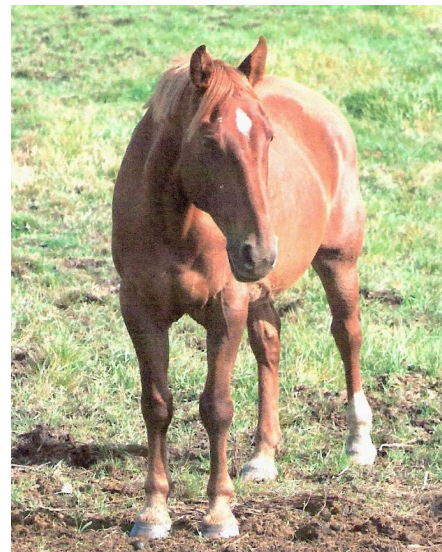
HORSE TALK
