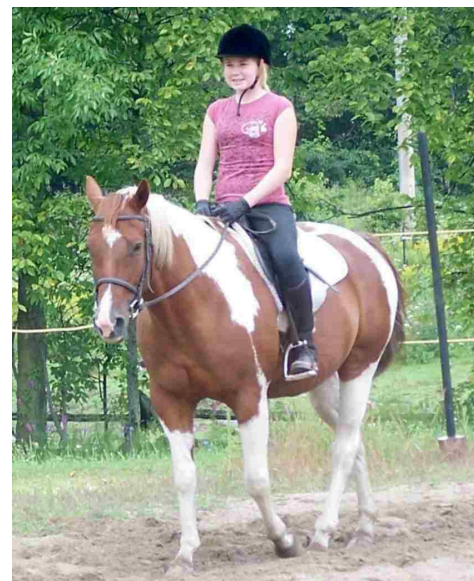
HORSE TALK
